Cubs:

Artist Badge p127 draw or paint an animal or person from memory or

Draw or paint a landscape from a photo or

sketch a character in more than one position- flip book or

create a greeting card or

printmaking in relief for wrapping paper or note cards, or drawn image

Handicraft Badge p132 toy made out of recycled materials or

detailed sculpture out of plasticine or

stick puppets, painted backdrops and flat table theatre

Scouts:

Builder Badge p159 a wire figure or wooden sculpture

Artist Badge p188 have 3 pieces of finished art work in drawing or painting or sculpture

Handicraft p190 carving a plaster plaque, or

embossing using printmaking methods or

carving in softoleum to create a stamp that is then printed

Modeller p194 model car or ship out of recycled materials or

Human or alien figure out of wire or

Mask or Relief Gargoyle out of plaster bandaging
